Maria Zolotaryova

On February, 27, 2009 *Maria Zolotaryova*, the lecturer of Kriviy Rig law faculty of the Dnepropetrovsk State University of Interior, defended successfully her dissertation in the specialized academic council K 08.727.02 in Dnepropetrovsk State University of Interior (Ukraine, Dnepropetrovsk).

The theme of dissertation was «Administrative - legal status of the state tax inspectorate of Ukraine» on a speciality 12.00.07.

The scientific adviser was Doctor of Law, professor Sergei Petkov, pro-rector of scientifically pedagogical work and international connections of Classical Private University.

Candidate of Law, associate professor *Andrei Manzhula*, the head of the faculty of administrative law and process of Kirovograd Law Institute of Kharkov National University of Interior.

The dissertation is devoted to the theoretical problems of definition of administrative - legal status of the State Tax Inspectorate of Ukraine and practical questions of its realization. In the dissertation the historical excursus in a question of STI formation in Ukraine is carried out and the essence and the contents of their administrative - legal status is analysed. The structure and normative legal regulation of administrative law status of STI are examined and the place and role of these bodies of state executive power in the system of tax bodies are investigated. Classification of STI powers as components of their administrative - legal status is carried out. The practice of legal regulation and realization of powers by STI concerning registration and accounting of tax and other payments payers, realization of tax control was analysed. The offers concerning the perfection of legal regulation of the administrative - legal status and practical realization of STI powers were offered with the purpose of solving the tasks put on them by the effective legislation.

On February, 28, 2009 **Sergei Tsariuk**, lecture of a cycle of criminal-legal disciplines of Chernigov college of law of the State department of Ukraine on questions of execution of punishments in special council of Dnepropetrovsk State University of Interior defended successfully dissertation on speciality 12.00.08. on theme «Criminal executive characteristic of condemned who serve the sentences in penal colonies of the highest security».

The scientific adviser was Doctor of Law, professor **Ivan Bogatyryov**, professor of faculty of criminal law disciplines of Dnepropetrovsk State University of Interior.

Official opponents:

Doctor of Law, professor of **Alexander Kolb** who is the director of criminal law and process department of Lesia Ukrainka Volynsk State University;

Candidate of Law, associate professor **Juriy Shinkarev**, the assistant of the dean of law faculty on scientific work of the Grygoriy Skovoroda Kharkov National Pedagogical University.

The dissertator carries out the research of the criminal executive characteristic of condemned and its place in the structure of the basic means of correction and resocialization in penal colonies of the highest security. The analysis of origin and formation of criminal executive characteristic of condemned is carried out, its functions and structure which allows to generate an idea about the course of execution process and serving of sentence in penal colonies of the given kind are determined.

The criminal executive characteristic of condemned who serve the sentences in these colonies is performed; it is offered to introduce some elements of progressive system of sentence serving by condemned to imprisonment for life. The criminal executive characteristic in structure of the basic means of correction and resocialization of condemned who serve the sentences in penal colonies of the highest security is investigated, that allows to determine the efficiency of their applying.

At the same session on February, 28, 2009 *Anna Reznichenko*, lecturer of criminal law and criminology faculty of Odessa State University Interior defended successfully dissertation to the specialized academic council K 08.727.02. The theme of her dissertation on the speciality 12.00.08. was «Features of execution and sentence servicing as imprisonment concerning the condemned women».

The scientific adviser was Doctor of Law, professor *Valentina Merkulova*, the first pro-rector of educational and methodical work of Odessa State University of Interior.

In the dissertation the features of execution and sentence servicing as imprisonment by the condemned women are investigated. The features of criminological, criminal legal and criminal executive characteristics of the women condemned to imprisonment are examined, features of keeping in minimum level of safety colonies with general conditions of keeping of condemned women, including pregnant women and women who have children under three. On the basis of this research a number of changes for the criminal executive legislation concerning the regulation of keeping condemned women in places of imprisonment was put forward.
