Dmitrieva Olga

Doctor of Medicine, Professor of Russian Academy of Natural Sciences, Head of the department of difficult examinations of Government Institution of Public Health Services «Primorsk regional bureau of forensic medical examination», director of forensic medicine department of Vladivostok State Medical University

Olga Dmitrieva was born on June 1. 1960 in Vladivostok (Russia). In 1977 she graduated from Vladivostok State Medical Institute on speciality Medical Business. Since 1980 she has been working as medical examiner in Primorsk regional bureau forensic medical examination. Since 2003 and now she is the head of the department of difficult examinations. Since 1995 she is also the assistant of forensic medicine department of Vladivostok State Medical University and since 2009 – head of the department.

In 2000 Olga Dmitrieva defended the Candidate's thesis in dissertational council D 208.070.01 at Federal government institute «Russian center of forensic medical examination». The theme of thesis was «Perfection of forensic medical methods of diagnostics of former sexual relations on cases about rape».

The research managers on the development of the given thesis were director of RC FME, professor, corresponding member of Pigolkin Russian Academy of Medical Sciences. Official opponents were Medical Doctor, professor R.Sakharov and Candidate of Medical Sciences, senior lecturer E.Barinov.

Olga Dmitrieva continued her scientific researches under the direction of professor Pigolkina, in 2003 she defended the thesis for doctor's degree on a theme «Perfection of forensic medical examination of sexual conditions of men».

The official opponents were Medical Doctor, professor D.Bogomolov, Medical Doctor, professor V.Zharov, Medical Doctor, professor, corresponding member of Russian Academy of Medical Sciences E.Mazo.
